INFORMATION SHEET

Conference Objective: Discussion and electronic publication of the scientific results of legal research conducted by scholars, doctoral candidates, postgraduates, students, and lawyers concerning the history and current state of human rights; legal assurance for the realization of rights, freedoms, and lawful interests of legal entities in Ukraine and the prospects for their improvement; functioning of civil society in conditions of martial law, an emergency situation, or a state of emergency; legal mechanisms for addressing socio-economic and socio-political issues of legal entities in postwar Ukraine; ensuring state security as a fundamental prerequisite for the realization of rights, freedoms, and lawful interests of legal entities in Ukraine; establishing contacts between scholars from different regions of Ukraine, exchanging scientific results and research experiences on issues of realizing rights, freedoms, and lawful interests of legal entities. Developing critical thinking among higher education seekers and lawyers, shaping their views and beliefs, ability to engage in discussion and make conclusions and suggestions on the given topic, and experience sharing.

**Venue:** Kyiv National University of Technologies and Design, Kyiv, Mala Shyianovska Street 2.

We invite scientists, postgraduates, master's students, higher education institution lecturers, teachers, and learners to participate in the conference.

Working languages of the conference – Ukrainian, English.

**Participation form in the conference** – mixed. All authors of the reports will receive a conference participant certificate, and the abstracts will be published in an electronic collection of conference materials.

### The conference will work in the following directions:

- 1. Human rights: theory and history of development in Ukraine and foreign countries.
- 2. Legal assurance for the realization of rights, freedoms, and lawful interests of legal entities in Ukraine and the prospects for their improvement.
- 3. Functioning of civil society in conditions of martial law, an emergency situation, or a state of emergency.
- 4. Legal mechanisms for addressing socio-economic and socio- political issues of legal entities in post-war Ukraine.
- 5. Ensuring state security as a fundamental prerequisite for the realization of rights, freedoms, and lawful interests of legal entities in Ukraine.
- 6. Anti-corruption and integrity: current state and directions of implementation.

### **Registration (Submission of information materials)**

To participate in the conference, it is necessary to send a **completed application** (form and sample attached) and abstract of the report (including the surname and initials of the scientific supervisor for individuals without a scientific degree) to the organizing committee **by September 8, 2024**, at the email address kgp@knutd.com.ua (with «Conference» specified in the subject line of the email).

The application file (registration form) is to be filled out in Ukrainian, except for the report topic, which is submitted in the language of the original. If the abstract is written in English, a Ukrainian translation should be added in brackets. The application should be saved in \*doc format. The file should be named after the author's surname, for example, Popova\_application.

#### Requirements for the preparation of abstracts of reports:

The length of the abstracts should be up to 5 pages, created using Word text editor in the form of a file with a \*doc extension. The orientation should be portrait, A4, with the font set to Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing at 1.5, and paragraph indentation at 10 mm. Margins are set at 2 cm on all sides - left, right, top, and bottom. Pages should not be numbered. The abstracts should not contain macros or word hyphenation.

Materials should be submitted in the following order:

- The name of the section according to the list specified above (font Times New Roman No. 14, aligned to the right)
- Centered surname, name, and patronymic of the author in bold font; scientific degree, academic title; full name of the institution where the author works or studies in italics. For participants who are higher education seekers or postgraduates, it's necessary to specify the surname and initials of the teacher who is the scientific supervisor, in bold font.
- The title of the abstract should be printed after one line spacing in the center of the line in capital letters, in bold font.
- References within the text should be indicated with square brackets, specifying the ordinal number of the source from the list, and after a comma the page number(s), for example: [7, p. 16].

The file should be named after the author's surname of the abstracts, for example, **Popova abstracts.**
