2 – Purpose of the educational program	
The purpose of the educational program is to train specialists with in-depth knowledge, as well as basic and professional competencies in the field of law, aimed at acquiring skills and abilities in the subject area through a deeper understanding of legal phenomena and processes, their causal relationships, as well as the formation of basic competencies necessary to understand the nature and functions of law, the content of major legal institutions, the application of law, as well as the limits of legal regulation of various social relations that will help in future professional activities, sufficient to effectively perform innovative tasks of the appropriate level of professional practice.	
3 – Characteristics of the educational program	
Subject area	Required training modules - 73% including: disciplines of general training – 4.5%, vocational training - 36%, practical training - 45%, learning a foreign language – 4.5%. Elective courses - 27% are selected from the university catalog in accordance with the approved procedure at the University.
Orientation of the educational program	Educational and professional program for master's degree preparation.
Focus of the program	Emphasis is placed on the formation and development of professional competencies in the field of law; study of theoretical and methodological provisions, organizational and practical tools.
Features of the educational program	The program is focused on mastering modern legal doctrines, interpretation of law and features of its application, taking into account the peculiarities of the business activities in the field of management, which are necessary for a lawyer.
4 – Suitability of graduates for employment and further training	
Suitability for employment	The graduate is suitable for employment in enterprises, organizations and institutions operating in the field of law: law firms, research and organizational and administrative institutions, sectoral institutions of various departments, public authorities, performing relevant functions in the field of law.

	Specialists are able to perform professional work in the areas of law enforcement, in particular, prosecutorial supervision, justice and law enforcement; civil service and local self-government.
